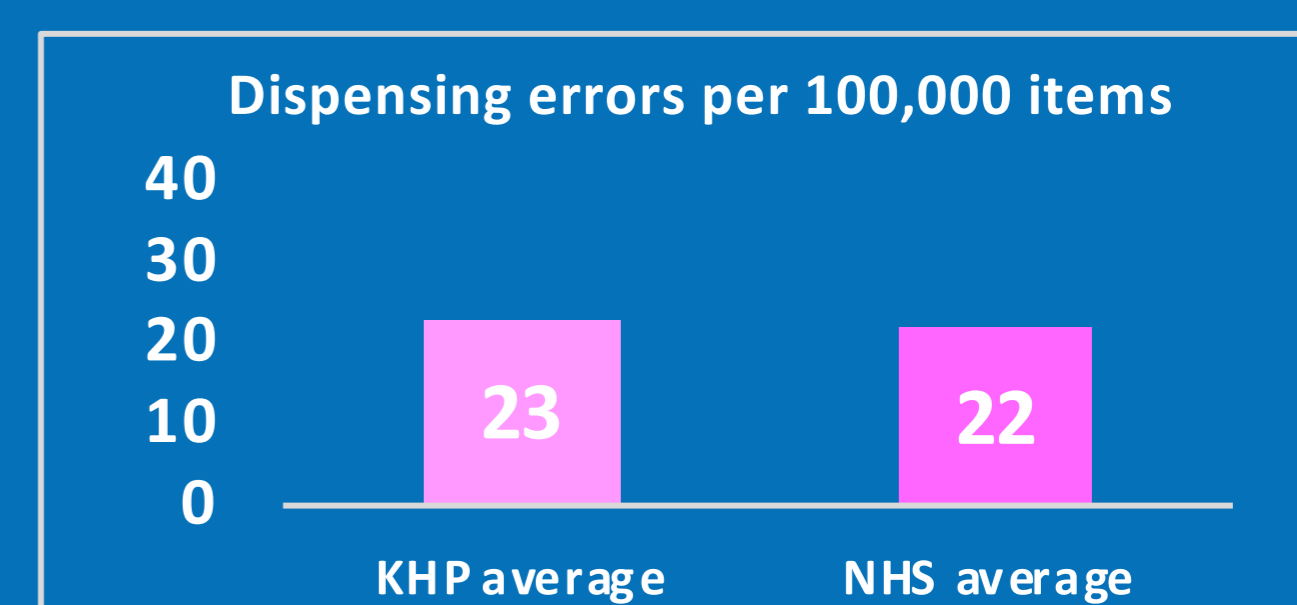
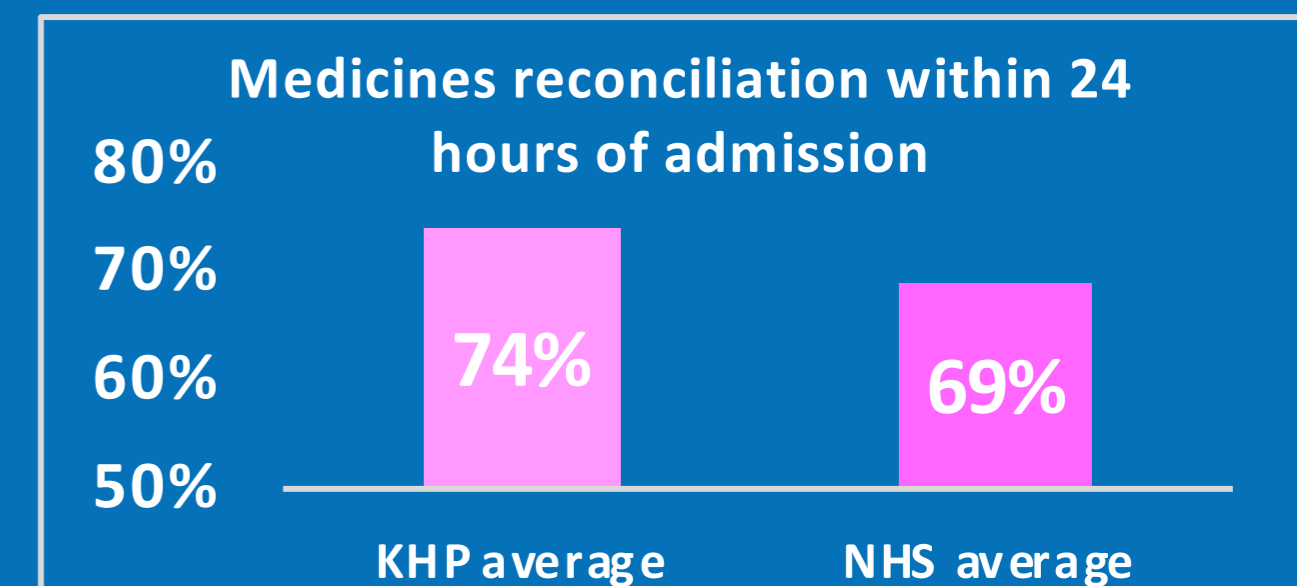
We have established a PhD programme for NHS pharmacists and scientists

91% of our MPharm graduates passed their GPhC pre-registration exam at the first attempt

Research

The research agenda of our CAG is broad, reflecting our 'bench to bedside' expertise from drug discovery, drug development through to medicines use in the real world

For REF 2021 we have already published **> 1,000** papers that have been cited **> 11,500** times



Attracted **>£2.6** million in research funding

95 PhD students registered with the Institute of Pharmaceutical Science



Publications have appeared in high impact journals including *NEJM*, *Chemical Reviews* and *BMJ*

We supported **659** clinical trials across KHP Trusts
