

### Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust



Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust is a world-class organisation with a proud history stretching back over 900 years. We are a centre of excellence for education, clinical services and research. Our clinical services are delivered from two of London's best known teaching hospitals, Guy's Hospital and St Thomas' Hospital, where Evelina London Children's Hospital is also located.

#### Project case study: Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO) in Qatar

Guy's and St Thomas' in a partnership with Hamad Medical Corporation (HMC) has supported the development of an outstanding clinical service: extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) in Qatar.

ECMO is a supportive therapy based on cardiac bypass technology that allows patients to be kept alive whilst the damage to their lungs heals. It is provided in an intensive care unit and requires highly complex multidisciplinary care.

The Guy's and St Thomas' ECMO service is one of the largest, most established and highest quality programmes for severe respiratory failure in the world, and managing more than 100 adults with the most severe form of respiratory failure each year.

### King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust



King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust is one of London's largest and busiest teaching hospitals with a unique set of specialist services. Established in 1840, King's College Hospital has been at the forefront of medical innovation for over 175 years. Today the hospital has 1,500 beds, 40 state of the art theatres and over 10,500 committed members of staff across a wide range of clinical specialities. We train more than 900 dentists, 750 doctors and 300 nurses every year.

#### Project case study: Kings College Hospital Clinic Abu Dhabi

In 2014, King's College Hospital opened a health clinic in Abu Dhabi. The clinic aims to provide high quality and cutting edge healthcare, and specialises in gynaecology, foetal medicine, paediatric, gastroenterology, as well as family and internal medicine.

KCH worked with three local partners that have assisted in setting up the clinic and establishing itself in the UAE. Opening the brand new facility had its challenges, but with the world-class reputation, knowledge and experience of King's College London, behind the project, it has been a growing success.

#### Project case study: Nanjing Nightingale Nursing College

King's College London's Faculty of Florence Nightingale Faculty of Nursing and Midwifery entered a ground breaking partnership with the Nanjing Health School in Jiangsu Province, China. The five year project will see King's providing consultancy, education and training to the Nanjing healthcare workforce and to establish a new 'Nanjing Nightingale Nursing College.'

The pairing of the most distinguished nursing faculty in the UK, working alongside a tripartite relationship of the Nanjing State Government, a brand new hospital and a nursing college will create a model for future educational and research partnership.

### South London and Maudsley NHS Foundation Trust

#### Project case study: Maudsley Child and Adolescent International Abu Dhabi

Maudsley Child and Adolescent International Abu Dhabi is a joint venture between South London and Maudsley NHS Foundation Trust and MACANI Medical Center, based in Abu Dhabi.

The service is delivered and managed by the trust, with a core team based in Abu Dhabi. Our clinicians visit Abu Dhabi regularly to provide additional expertise, training and consultation.

South London and Maudsley's mission is 'to achieve the best possible outcomes for children and young people with mental health problems living in the Middle East'.
