

We have established a PhD programme for NHS pharmacists and scientists

The Royal Pharmaceutical Society Hospital recommends the meaningful benchmarking of pharmacy services. As part of The Pharmacy and Medicines Optimisation Exercise of 2018, we know:



**126** students graduated with an MPharm degree including 90% with a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2:1

**91%** of our MPharm graduates passed their GPhC pre-registration exam at the first attempt

79% was the national average

## Research

The research agenda of our CAG is broad, reflecting our 'bench to bedside' expertise from drug discovery, drug development through to medicines use in the real world

For REF 2021 we have already published **> 1,000** papers that have been cited **> 11,500** times



Attracted **>£2.6** million in research funding

**95** PhD students registered with the Institute of Pharmaceutical Science



Publications have appeared in high impact journals including *NEJM*, *Chemical Reviews* and *BMJ*

We supported **659** clinical trials across KHP Trusts



For REF 2014 **2<sup>nd</sup>** of out **94** for research power



**50%** of our papers were with international collaborators

**8** staff have had **40** papers cited a minimum of **40x** **4** staff have had **50** papers cited a minimum of **50x**



**91%** of our research was rated as internationally excellent or world-leading
